ORDER

THIS CAUSE came to be heard upon this Court's Order dated August 26, 2016, scheduling a hearing for October 5, 2016 "on whether [Ryan Herbert King's] guardianship should be terminated."

The Court received evidence that Mr. King is able to make and communicate his own decisions and direct his own life, with the support of his family, using "Supported Decision-Making." In reliance upon this evidence, Mr. King, through counsel, made an oral Motion that his guardianship be terminated.

Upon consideration of the evidence and argument submitted and heard, the Court finds as follows:

- (1) That Mr. King, through his use of Supported Decision-Making, is able to "receive and evaluate information effectively," "communicate decisions," "manage [his] financial resources," and "meet the essential requirements for his physical health, safety, habilitation, or therapeutic needs" without the need for a guardian or conservator.
- (2) That Mr. King is not an "incapacitated individual" as that term is defined in D.C. Code § 21-2011(11).

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED**

- (1) That Mr. King's Motion to terminate his guardianship is **GRANTED**; and

(2) That the guardianship over Mr. King, created through Order of this Court dated on or about December 9, 2003, be and hereby is **TERMINATED**.
