ORDER TO TERMINATE GUARDIANSHIP

This matter comes to the Court on the Petition to Terminate Guardianship filed by Jamie Beck.

The Court, having reviewed the Petition, and having held a hearing on June 13, 2018, finds:

1. Jamie Beck is capable of competently managing her affairs through the utilization of formal and informal supports; the latter of which have been solemnized in a Support Decision-Making Agreement ("SDMA").
2. Jamie is no longer an "Incapacitated Person" as defined by Indiana Code 29-3-1-7.5; and therefore, termination of the Letters of Guardianship over her person and estate is appropriate pursuant to Indiana Code 29-3-12-1(b)(1).
3. By consent of the parties, the Court shall maintain limited jurisdiction over this matter, and a status hearing will be scheduled in order for the Court to be apprised of any successes or difficulties resulting from Jamie's use of the SDMA as an alternative to guardianship; and so the Court can take appropriate action, if necessary.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Letters of Guardianship over the person and estate of Jamie Lavonne Beck are hereby terminated. Additionally, a status hearing is scheduled for **December 7, 2018** at **9:00 A.M.**
